MONTREAL: Bruno Giros, PhD, a researcher at the Douglas Mental Health University Institute and a professor in the Department of Psychiatry at McGill University, has demonstrated, for the first time, the role that dopamine plays in a region of the brain called the hippocampus. Published in *Biological Psychiatry*, this discovery opens the door to a better understanding of psychiatric diseases, such as schizophrenia.
